Cartoon etiquette guide

Welcome to Cartoonmuseum Basel. We are pleased that you are interested in narrative drawing and would like to experience comics, cartoons and caricatures as originals. To enable us to offer this advantage to all our exhibitions' visitors, we need your assistance. We ask that you observe the following advice when visiting with your group.

Booking	Please book your group visit 14 days in advance.
Cloakroom	Coats, bags, umbrellas, food and drink must be left in the cloakroom.
Photography	If you take photographs, please never use a flash. Maintain a distance of 50 cm from the picture.
Group size	For an optimal visit, we recommend a group size of 10, with division of larger groups into several smaller groups.
Distance	Please maintain a distance of at least 50 cm from the exhibits, so as to avoid contact.
Notes	Working with pencil and a suitable pad or board is allowed. Please do not draw on the display cases. Use our tables in the library.
Responsibility	We ask you to inform your group about these rules and to follow the instructions of the museum staff and mediators. As a teacher and group leader, you are responsible for the behaviour of your group.

We thank you for your courtesy and hope you enjoy yourselves immensely in the realm of narrative drawing.
